



ACTIVITIES

BOOKING AN ACTIVITY

Individuals or groups with 1-5 participants can book ahead of time on our self-serve online system at zephyrpoint.org/activities/. You can also check availability upon arrival through the same online system. Reservations will always be based on availability and staffing.

Groups of 6 or more participants must make a reservation at least 10 days prior to the scheduled activity. Most of the bookings are on the same system as listed above but require more communication with the Activities Coordinator. You can reach the activities coordinator by email at activities@zephyrpoint.org or by phone at (775) 588-6759 ext. 114.

Most activities are available for both individuals/families and large groups. However, the booking process is often based on capacity, so please read carefully prior to officially booking any activities. If you need help, reach out to the Activities Coordinator (contact information above).

PAYMENT

Payments are typically processed through an online booking system specifically for activities (see the link above to book an activity). These payments can be made online at the time of booking. For some activities we have the option to “walk-up” and pay on the spot. See below for the details, costs and booking availability for each activity.

Rental Equipment

WATERCRAFT RENTALS

Weather Disclaimer:

Watercraft rentals are always weather dependent and may be canceled at any time. Lake Tahoe generally has very pleasant weather in the summer, however, we do experience a great deal of wind, especially in the afternoons. The word *ZEPHYR* literally means “wind.” Kayaking, paddleboarding, and canoeing are unsafe in extreme wind, therefore, at our discretion we may cancel your watercraft rental at any time, even after you are already out on the water.

Cancellation Policy:

If Zephyr Point chooses to cancel your rental prior to your reservation time, you will receive a full refund. If you choose to start the rental, even with a wind warning knowing there's a risk you could be called in early, you are responsible for the entire cost. If we give a warning prior to your reservation and you choose not to go out to not risk it, we will allow for a full refund.

All other cancellations made more than 1 hour prior to the reservation start time will be eligible for a full refund. Within 1 hour of the reservation, you are responsible for the full cost. This cancellation policy is stated again during the booking process for your reference.

Damage or Theft:

Upon booking, you will check a box acknowledging that you could be liable for up to \$200 per boat if a boat is not returned or if there is any damage.

Watercraft Guidelines:

- Every participant must fill out our Activities Liability Waiver (minors must have a parent/legal guardian fill out the form)
- Lifejackets must be worn at all times on the boat.
- No boats inside the "swim area" (within the docks).
- All boats must remain within eyesight of the Zephyr Point docks.

When selecting, keep in mind that each booking is per hour with the option to book up to 3 hours. Zephyr Point will have at least one staff member facilitating the rental process and managing all renters. Zephyr Point staff are responsible for getting all boats and equipment ready, checking to make sure every participant filled out the Activities Liability Waiver, and managing the watercraft rental guidelines. Zephyr Point staff is *not* out on the water in a boat with renters, does *not* necessarily have a lifeguard certification, and is not responsible for managing behavior of group members.

Group rentals:

During the initial booking, the group leader must select the activity date, time frame, and number of boats, then pay for the activity. Final numbers (number of people, number of boats, and types of boats) and any other changes to the reservation are due 24 hours prior to the reservation. Groups are responsible to pay for the total number of boats selected at the 24 hour mark, even if not everyone shows up.

The boats reserved are your group's to use for the duration of the rental window, so you are allowed to switch between people within the hour *within reason*, as long as every person participating has completed the waiver.

EQUIPMENT RENTALS

Group Rentals:

Upon booking, you will check a box acknowledging that you could be liable for up to \$200 if the item is not returned or if there is any damage.

For Guest Groups: The items below need to be reserved ahead of time as part of your reservation. To register, talk with your Conference Coordinator to add them to your reservation. Please make this reservation at least 10 days prior to your arrival date and no more than 90 days out. See below for details of when these items are available.

For Cabin Guests or Individuals: These items are available for individuals and families to rent by contacting your Cabin Coordinator who will add them to your initial booking (this is different from most other activities). Please reserve the items within 10 days of the reservation time.

Individual and/or Group Rentals:

The items below can be rented from the Front Office. You *do not* need to reserve these ahead of time but can if you want guaranteed availability. These items will be available in the office year-round, however, most of them are weather-dependent and will be best used in the Summer/Fall months.

Upon booking, you will check a box acknowledging that you could be liable if the item is not returned or if there is any damage. The hammocks and lifejackets could have up to a \$50 damage/theft fee. All the other items on the list below could have up to a \$20 damage/theft fee.

Winter Rentals:

These items are available during our Winter and Spring months of November-April (weather permitting). For both items, the meeting place/pick-up place will be in the front office.

Upon booking, you will check a box acknowledging that you could be liable for up to \$100 if the item is not returned or if there is any damage.

Facilitated Activities

ARCHERY

20-minute lesson at the beginning for all groups

Max of 6 people in a “shooting group” based on our number of targets

Any number over a multiple of 6 will create a new “shooting group”

If you have more than 12 people in your group, we ask that you book multiple sessions.

Cancellation Policy:

Any cancellations made more than 24 hours prior to the reservation start time will be eligible for a full refund. Within 24 hours of the reservation, you are responsible for the full cost.

PRIVATE EVENTS

Cancellation Policy:

Any cancellations made more than 24 hours prior to the event’s start time will be eligible for a full refund. Within 24 hours of the event, you are responsible for the full cost.
