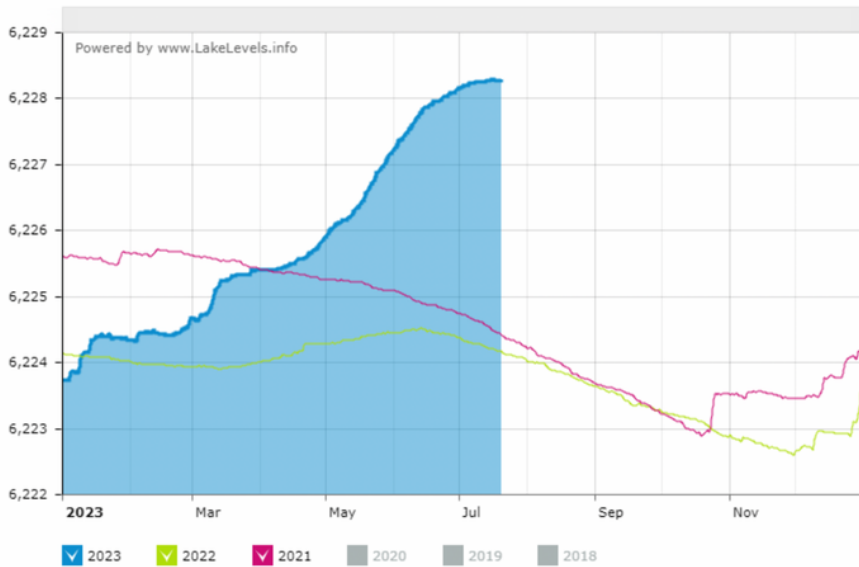

Summer is always a wonderful and busy time at Zephyr Point. With 2022-2023 winter and its record-breaking snowfall it has caused the level of Lake Tahoe to rise significantly. As of June 20th, 2023, Lake
