ZEPHYR POINT HISTORY

It was at the 1937 Presbyterian Synod meeting that Mrs. Dobbins took notice of the precarious descent via the old wooden staircase from the landing above. On her husband's birthday, she was moved to donate \$1,000 toward the eventual installation of the beautiful rock staircase which came to be called "Robin's Flight" after Mrs. Robin Dobbins, affectionately known by family and friends as Mother Robin.

The flight began as a waterfall, complete with fish. Flowers were more fitting, however, and a lovely attraction was born. The latest update to Robin's Flight includes a new and more sturdy metal handrail as well as low voltage lighting that illuminates the staircase at night.
